- Go4Schools will provide an overview of work set, but it simply a replication of what is already in Teams.
- Email is always available for help and support but will not be used to set work.

INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT FOR PUPILS

Email teachers or use the posts section in Teams to get help from a teacher

GO4SCHOOLS

An extra resource for parents and pupils. It gives an OVERVIEW of all work set. Pupils can also tick off work completed. It will also SIGNPOST pupils to where to find tasks and resources.

RESOURCES -

Worksheets and other resources will only be available in Teams (through Assignments or class notebook). These will often be documents that the pupils can edit and hand in.
