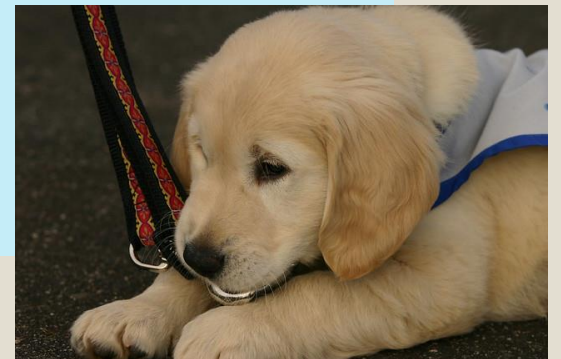




GUIDE DOGS – LET'S DO THIS!

# We have a target of just under £1000!

- Our current amount stands at £1600 - which is amazing - well done everyone!
- As you know, we are aiming to get to £2500, in order to NAME A PUPPY!
- This will be a puppy which will be trained as a guide dog, and will eventually go on to change someone's life who has lost their sight - we're naming a true hero!!
- The money we raise will go towards supporting the training of our puppy.
- We have until JULY!!



# July is our target!

- £1000 is entirely possible for our school community
- If every pupil raised just £10, we'd have over £5000, so £1000 should be easy!
- So...here's the plan:
- On the website, there is a new 'JustGiving' link to our Guide Dogs account.
- We are asking **EACH PUPIL IN THE SCHOOL** to choose a way they PERSONALLY will help to raise some money.

# You could:

- Agree to do some jobs at home for money towards Guide Dogs.
  - Eg - tidy your room, wash the car, make tea, load/empty the dishwasher all week etc...
- Decide to give a percentage of any pocket money you receive to Guide Dogs
- Do a sponsored activity (walk / silence / read etc) and raise money that way.
- Something entirely original and creative!

It's up to you what you do, but we'd like every pupil to commit to at least one thing.

# Once you've raised your money:

- *Get the money paid straight into the JustGiving account.*
- Give the details of what you have done, and how much you raised to the nominated member of your tutor's leadership team.
- *This person will then submit your fundraising details to Ms Smith.*
- You will then receive 2 housepoints for every task. If the task is a big one (*eg a sponsored 5K run*) you will receive 5 housepoints.
- *It doesn't matter how much you raise - every penny counts!*
- If you have any photos of your fundraising, you may post them on your house teams' 'Guide Dogs Fundraising' channel.

# Now's the time to decide!

- During next week's PER, your form tutor will ask you to write down what you will commit to doing for Guide Dogs (of course, you may already have done it by then!)
- Please have your idea ready by next week. Your form tutor will be checking in with each of you in the summer term, to make sure you haven't forgotten.
- A letter is going home to inform your parents and carers about our plans. Please have a chat with them about what you can do.
- Remember, it's not about how much you raise, it's to do with thinking about others, and trying to make a difference.
