# **Go4Schools Guide General Information**

Go4schools is our online platform of communication between school and home, accessed through a desktop site or a smartphone app. It brings together important, up-to-the-minute information about your child's learning, behaviour and attendance, sending parents notifications about key information.

The Go4schools system will enable you to access the following information at any time:

#### Behaviour

Pupils are awarded positive and negative behaviour scores during lessons. These are tracked on Go4Schools and available for parents to see daily. A summary can be seen under this section, giving you the ability to be able to discuss this with you child and be more informed about their day.

This is useful to see if positive or negative behaviours are occurring in certain lessons.

Green events- exceptional behaviour, going beyond expectations

Red events - falling short of expected behaviour

### Homework

You will be able to view homework set by your child's class teacher, an approximate guide time, the date it was set and when it is due in.

You may also find equipment lists for some lessons, homework help and resources, the class teachers name that you should contact should there be an issue with the task set.

Please be aware that your child will need to log into their account and tick off when they have completed their task.

#### Attendance

This information is always shown up to the previous day. You can click on the blue attendance to view a more comprehensive breakdown of your child's attendance, day-by-day.

#### **Timetable**

You will be able to view your child's daily and weekly timetable. Click on "view full timetable" to see the full week.

## **School Reports**

Termly 'snapshot' progress reports or more detailed main reports are published in Go4School.

You can access a report by clicking the 'View report' links. You can then also download and print copies of the reports which will be available for the whole of the year.

This function will not be available until reports are published later in the year. We will notify you whenever we publish a report.
